ATLANTA CHAPTER SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION AND GUIDELINES

The purpose of the AABE Atlanta Chapter Scholarship is to assist African American, Hispanic and Native American students with the cost of pursuing a Bachelor's degree in an energy related field, at an accredited college/university.

ELGIBILITY

Candidates for an AABE scholarship must meet the following eligibility criteria:

- Student must be a U. S. Citizen and a resident of Georgia.
- Student must attend a metro Atlanta area high school.
- Student must have a B (or better) average or a grade point average (GPA) of 3.0 or higher on a 4.0 scale and a minimum Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT) score of 1400 or American College Testing (ACT) composite score of 19.
- Student must graduate by June 30, 2011 from an accredited high school institution.
- Student should be involved in community/civic service activities.
- Student must have two recommendations (one from a teacher or counselor and the other non-academic).
- Student must submit an essay (300 word minimum/350 word maximum) stating why they should receive an AABE scholarship, personal career objectives and any additional information to assist the selection committee.
- Students must plan to major in approved business, engineering, mathematics and physical science (astronomy, chemistry, geology, mineralogy, meteorology, physics) i.e., energy industry related fields.
- Upon notification as an award recipient, student must provide an acceptance letter from an accredited college/university before the awards ceremony, which is scheduled to be held on Thursday, May 12, 2011 at 4:00 p.m. in Atlanta.

SELECTION

Scholarship recipients are determined on the basis of merit, academic achievement, community involvement, career goals and aspirations. Candidate applications will be reviewed by the AABE Atlanta Chapter Scholarship Committee.

NOTIFICATION

All scholarship applicants will be notified of their status by April 29, 2011.

AWARDS

Scholarships will be awarded in varying amounts. The AABE Atlanta Chapter Scholarship Committee determines actual amounts.

THE APPLICATION PACKAGE

Consideration will ONLY be given to candidates submitting complete application packages, which include:

- Completed 2011 AABE Scholarship Application Form (copies are acceptable)
 - Include email address of the candidate and/or parents in the application
- "Official" high school transcript
- A well written essay (typed, double-spaced, 300 word minimum / 350 word maximum)
- Two letters of recommendation (one from a teacher or counselor, and the other non-academic)
- Must submit a completed and signed checklist
- GPA scores should be converted and provided on a 4.0 scale
- Must provide official proof of ACT or SAT scores

Completed application packages must be received by MARCH 11, 2011 to be considered for an AABE Atlanta Chapter Scholarship, and sent to the following address...
