SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION AND GUIDELINES

The American Association of Blacks in Energy, through its Scholarship Program, seeks to help increase the number of African Americans, Hispanics and Native Americans (underrepresented minorities) in energy related fields. By doing so, we help our nation address a critical need and a challenge to our future economic vitality in the world market.

Eligibility

Candidates for an AABE scholarship must meet the following eligibility criteria:

- Have an overall "B" academic average (3.0 or better on a 4.0 scale).
- Be a graduating high school senior who has applied to one or more 4 year accredited colleges/universities.
- Plan to major in Engineering, Engineering/Computer Technology, Mathematics or the Physical Science fields (Chemistry, Geology, Meteorology, and Physics only please).
- Demonstrate financial need.
- Be recognized as a member of one of the underrepresented minority groups (African American, Hispanic or Native American) in the sciences and related areas of technology.
- Submission and receipt of completed scholarship application packet by stated due date as given below.

Selection

Scholarship recipients - known as AABE Scholars - are determined each spring by the organization's local chapter scholarship committee for local scholarships and selected applications may be submitted to the National Scholarship Committee for national scholarships. All eligible applicants will be notified of the selection decisions for the local level scholarships.

Awards

The Mississippi Chapter of AABE will award one (1) \$2,000 scholarship and three (3) or more \$1,000 scholarships.

The top local application(s) is/are forwarded to compete for a Southwest Regional Award of \$3,000 (The Southwest Region is one of six AABE Regions). Additionally, a Premier Award of \$5,000 is given annually to the candidate who is judged to demonstrate the most outstanding achievement and promise by the National committee. National Awards are made to the students upon presentation of proof of enrollment at an accredited college or university. Distribution of local chapter awards is made in installments by the local chapter upon proof of enrollment at an accredited college or university. Scholarship awards are subject to forfeiture should the recipients' major change to an ineligible field of study as outlined above.

The Application Package

Consideration will be given only to candidates submitting complete application packages which include: (1) a completed AABE application form (copies are acceptable); (2) a high school transcript; (3) official proof of ACT or SAT scores; (4) two letters of reference; (5) parent(s)/ guardian(s) official verification of income i.e., copy of a signed 2009 tax return or a verified FAFSA form; and (6) the completed AABE Scholarship Application Checklist. Please remove Social Security Numbers from any documents.

*Complete application packages **MUST BE POSTMARKED NO LATER THAN March 19, 2010** and submitted to the local AABE chapter listed below. **** Applications returned to the AABE national office or the National Scholarship Committee is in violation of procedures and will not be considered for scholarship support at the local, regional or national levels.***

- I am one of the underrepresented minorities (African American, Hispanic or Native American) in the sciences and related area of technology.
- I have submitted a completed AABE application form (copies are acceptable).
- I have attached an official verification of Parent(s) or guardian income, (Copy of signed 2009 tax return; 1098; 1099; or public assistance income verification from 2009 or a verified FAFSA form).
- I have attached an official current high school transcript with documented GPA.
- I have composed and included the requested essay.
- I have attached a copy of the official record of my ACT and/or SAT scores or it is documented on my official high school transcript.
- I have identified the number of dependent siblings and/or dependent children living in my home along with the ages of those siblings or children.
- I have attached two (2) letters of reference.
- I have additional sheets, as needed, to list all of my school and community extracurricular activities.
- I have made the best effort to remove any Social Security numbers on accompanying documents.
- My name appears on ALL attachments.

Applications will not be reviewed without the completed checklist attached and counselor signature and requested information. Any omissions or misrepresentations of the truth will be grounds for disqualification.
