#### ATLANTA CHAPTER SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION AND GUIDELINES

The purpose of the AABE Atlanta Chapter Scholarship is to assist African American, Hispanic and Native American students with the cost of pursuing a Bachelor's degree at an accredited institution in energy related fields.

#### **ELGIBILITY**

Candidates for an AABE scholarship must meet the following eligibility criteria:

- Student must be a U. S. Citizen and a resident of Georgia.
- Student must attend a greater Atlanta area high school.
- Student must have a B (or better) average or a grade point average (GPA) of 3.0 or higher on a 4.0 scale and a minimum Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT) score of 1400 or American College Testing (ACT) Composite Score of 19.
- Student must graduate by June of 2009
- Student should be involved in community/civic service activities.
- Student must have two recommendations (one from a teacher or counselor and the other non-academic).
- Student must submit an essay of 350 words (minimum) stating why they should receive an AABE scholarship, personal career objectives and any additional information to assist the selection committee.
- Students who plan to major in approved business, engineering, mathematics and science fields.
- Upon notification as an award recipient, student must produce an acceptance letter from an accredited
  institution before the awards ceremony, which is scheduled to be held at Georgia Power's corporate
  headquarters in downtown Atlanta, Georgia, in May, 2009.

#### **SELECTION**

Scholarship recipients are determined by the AABE Atlanta Chapter Scholarship Committee.

#### **AWARDS**

Scholarships will be awarded in varying amounts. The AABE Atlanta Chapter Scholarship Committee determines actual amounts.

#### THE APPLICATION PACKAGE

Consideration will be given ONLY to candidates submitting complete application packages, which include:

- Completed 2009 AABE Scholarship Application Form (copies are acceptable)
  - Include email address of the candidate and/or parents in the application
  - Redact Social Security Numbers from Application Package
- "Official" high school transcript
- A well written essay (minimum of 350 words)
- Two letters of recommendation (one academic and one non-academic)
- Must submit a completed and signed checklist
- GPA scores should be converted and provided on a 4.0 scale
- Must provide official proof of ACT or SAT scores

\*\*COMPLETE APPLICATION PACKAGES MUST BE RECEIVED BY <u>FEBRUARY 6, 2009</u> TO BE CONSIDERED FOR AN ATLANTA CHAPTER AABE SCHOLARSHIP.
