Marie Knox is currently a Technical Trainer in Operations for the Midcontinent ISO (MISO) where her responsibilities include developing, and delivering North American Electric Reliability Corporation (NERC) certified system operator accredited training on reliable electric grid operations.

As an Advisor, Marie's previous responsibilities included providing expertise into the development of electric industry standards through: NERC, North American Energy Standards Board (NAESB), and Regional Entities. She collaborated with industry professionals and MISO stakeholders to leverage efforts. In this role she led the design and implementation of standards compliance training for MISO staff.

Prior to working for MISO, Marie worked for the utility Illinois Power (currently known as Ameren Illinois) dispatching generation and scheduling transmission.
